



CUREPE INTERCHANGE PROJECT

REMOVAL OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT TWO (2) INTERSECTIONS ALONG THE CHURCHILL ROOSEVELT HIGHWAY

(U-turn in the vicinity of the Cipriani College of Labour and Cooperative Studies and the Churchill Roosevelt Highway and Prince Charles Avenue, Valsayn Intersection)

The National Infrastructure Development Company Limited (NIDCO) in partnership with the Ministry of Works and Transport (MOWT) wishes to advise the general public (motorists/residents) that the Curepe Interchange Project is expected to be substantially completed by the end of April 2020. In an effort to achieve this timeline and facilitate the completion of construction works it has now become necessary to introduce the following temporary changes in traffic movements:

Motorists/Residents/Pedestrians are advised that effective Monday 6th April, 2020 at 9am there will be a permanent closure of the:

- U-turn in the vicinity of the Cipriani Labour College; and
- right turn from Prince Charles Avenue, Valsayn to the CRH Westbound.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE

Motorists/residents who utilized the U-turn, in the vicinity of Cipriani Labour College, to access the CRH Westbound are advised to use the following alternative routes:

• Motorists/residents travelling east along the CRH from Port of Spain and environs who wish to proceed west to Bamboo No. 2, Grand Bazaar and environs are advised to keep left on the CRH and proceed to the Mount Hope Roundabout via the northbound section of the Uriah Butler Highway (UBH). At the roundabout take the fourth exit to proceed south along the UBH and follow the directional signs to access final destination.

a U-turn at the CRH and Southern Main Road Intersection (Curepe Lights) to access the westbound section of the CRH and final destination.

Motorists/residents who utilized the right turn from Prince Charles Avenue, Valsayn to access the CRH Westbound are advised to use the following alternative route:


Motorists/residents traveling south along Prince Charles Avenue, Valsayn who wish to proceed west to Bamboo No. 2, Grand Bazaar, San Fernando, Port of Spain and environs are advised to turn left on to the eastbound section of the CRH. Motorists/ residents should merge to the right lane and make a U-turn at the CRH and Southern Main Road Intersection (Curepe Lights) to access the westbound section of the CRH and final destination.

Motorists are further advised to comply with following:

- proceed with caution and drive at a reduced speed on approaching the work zone;
- observe all directional signage and barriers provided on the approaches to the site;
- be aware of heavy equipment entering and exiting the site; and
- comply with instructions issued by police officers to facilitate a safe and orderly flow of traffic.

All precautions are being taken by the MOWT, NIDCO and its Contractor to guarantee proper Health, Safety and Environmental Standards are maintained.
