

PUBLIC NOTICE TEMPORARY TRAFFIC DISRUPTION

SIR SOLOMON HOCHOY HIGHWAY (SOUTH BOUND), 34.0KM TO 35.5KM MARK

This has become necessary in order to facilitate a Road Marking exercise (painting).
