

## MAJOR DESILTING AND FLOOD ALLEVIATION PROGRAMME ACROSS TRINIDAD

The Ministry of Works and Transport's (MOWT) Drainage Division has set a target of three hundred and sixty nine (369) active desilting projects across Trinidad. This number surpasses the Division's target in 2017 and 2018.

To treat with drainage and flooding throughout the country, the MOWT has developed a short, medium and long term strategy. The short term plan includes the National Desilting Programme which is a recurrent maintenance strategy that assists with managing the country's drainage capacity.

Phase 1 of the programme was launched in January, 2019 and encompassed a total of one hundred and fourteen (114) projects; all of which have been completed to date. The MOWT is pleased to announce that Phase 2 is also completed and Phase 3 of this programme was fully operationalized in June, 2019 with one hundred and fifty (150) active projects.

## **CARONI RIVER IMPROVEMENT WORKS**

Historically, the Caroni River and its fenceline communities have always had the propensity for flooding. Combined with increased rainfall due to climate change, the MOWT despite financial constraints, invested greater efforts and resources to protect communities that are most vulnerable to flooding in the Caroni district. The scope of work entails the rehabilitation of existing embankments at intermittent locations from St Helena to El Socorro South.

It also includes the installation of new drainage structures with flap gates at eight (8) sites. To date, embankment works have been completed on the north bank, both upstream and downstream of the ByPass Road Piarco for a distance of approximately 1500 metres. At Church Street, Kelly Village, 200m of berm and embankment works have also been completed. Works are currently ongoing at Sheldon Trace, St Helena, Caroni Village, Caroni and El Socorro South. In addition, the Ministry of Works and Transport is procuring three mobile pumps to further assist with flood alleviation within the area.

## PORT OF SPAIN FLOOD ALLEVIATION PROJECT

During the 2018/2019 period, the Ministry completed considerable works on the Port of Spain Flood Alleviation project. Phase 1 of the project included the construction of drainage channels which capture water flow from the bottom of Charlotte Street to Broadway Intersection, then from Broadway Intersection to the Cove, south of the Lighthouse where a detention pond was constructed at an elevated level above mean sea level. The detention pond will be outfitted with flap gates and pumps which will control the flow and removal of water, based on tide levels.

Phase 2 includes the construction of a secondary drainage system to further alleviate flooding within the Port of Spain area. Designs for Phase 2 have been completed and include the construction of 180m of box culvert drains, one detention pond and one flap gate.
