Temporary Traffic Disruption Tarouba Link Road, 0.8km mark, San Fernando

The Ministry of Works and Transport wishes to advise the public that there will be a temporary traffic disruption along the **Tarouba Link Road 0.8km mark in the vicinity of the UTT San Fernando Campus**, effective **Monday 13th March, 2023 to Monday 27th March, 2023**. This is to facilitate **Slope Stabilization works**.

The hours of work are from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

In light of the above, motorists are advised to comply with the following:-

- Proceed with caution and observe all directional signs and barriers.
- Comply with instructions from Police Officers or flag persons on-site, to facilitate a safe and orderly flow of traffic.
- Be aware of equipment in the work zone and entering / exiting the site.
- Motorists should drive at a reduced speed and proceed with caution, on approaching the work zone.
- No shoulder access would be available at the workzone
