- 1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Control (Green Band Citation Maxi-Taxi) Order, 2025.
 - 2. This Order comes into operation on Thursday 17th April, 2025. Commencemen
- 3. In this Order, "green band maxi-taxi" means a maxi-taxi painted Interpretation with green bands in accordance with the Maxi-Taxi Regulations. $\frac{\text{L.N. No. }109}{\text{of }1992}$
- 4. A person plying for hire a green band maxi-taxi shall not enter No entry the following roads from the Southern Main Road:
 - (a) Lance Murray Avenue; and
 - (b) the un-named road located on the southern side of the Curepe Community Centre, between Palm Drive Circular on the west and the Southern Main Road on the east.
