## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

## THIS IS AN OFFICIAL NOTICE OF THE IMPOSITION OF SANCTIONS BY THE LICENSING AUTHORITY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 88C OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 48:50.

This is an official Notice of the Imposition of Administrative Sanctions by the Licensing Authority for **UNPAID** Fixed Penalty Notices (Traffic Tickets) issued during the period **May 27, 2020 to December 31, 2021**.

Public notices were previously published in the Trinidad Express, Trinidad Guardian and Trinidad Newsday on May 8th, 11th and 13th, 2022 respectively, advising that a listing of unpaid and uncontested Fixed Penalty Notice(s) with the recipients' names was posted to the Ministry's website. This measure was adopted since the Transport Commissioner, as the Licensing Authority, intended to impose administrative sanctions in accordance with **Sections 88A-88B of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act, Chap. 48:50** as a result of the following:

- 1. There was no record of payment of the outstanding fixed penalty amount within the prescribed thirty (30) day period for payment;
- 2. There was no record of a Notice to Contest being filed with the Court for the Fixed Penalty Notice(s); and
- 3. The fixed penalty plus one-half (50%) of the amount of the fixed penalty are **overdue for payment**.

Also, persons were given the opportunity to either pay the outstanding fixed penalty or make written representations and provide reasons why administrative sanctions should not be imposed by the Licensing Authority. Recipients of Fixed Penalty Notices issued during the period **May 27**, **2020 to December 31**, **2021** are advised that, in the absence of payment of the outstanding fixed penalty and the submission of written representations to date, with effect from **October 03**, **2022** the Transport Commissioner will be imposing the following administrative sanctions in accordance with **Section 88C** of the **Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act**, **Chap. 48:50**:

- cease all transactions in relation to the motor vehicle which was involved in the commission of the traffic violation
- cease all transactions in relation to the driver or owner of the said motor vehicle, which was involved in the commission of the traffic violation.

The public is advised that such administrative sanctions can be removed/lifted immediately upon the payment of the outstanding fixed penalty amount (fixed penalty plus 50% of that amount) at any authorised **TTPost** location nationwide.
